A brief introduction...Our core program, Cycling Without Age Sorrento, commenced in January 2018; is supported by our charity, Motion by the Ocean Inc. We provide free daily Trishaw service that provides rides elderly and disabled communities. The most regular service of our type in Australia.

Being Western Australia's founding free Trishaw service, we provide an innovative vehicle for change. The interaction between our passengers, vollies and the community helps our passengers feel valued and relevant in their own communities. We believe the salt, sand and sea is free therapy for us all.

While our Trishaws were temporarily out of service, while we navigated CV19, we re imagined our purpose and partnered with the country's largest food recovery agencies to deliver food hampers to our seniors that need them most. Our Moving Food Program was established, distributing and delivering the equilivent of 39,000 meals!





We give thanks to the City of Joondalup who funded the signage on our van, our new uniforms, as well as the fit out of our new storage unit in Hillarys. We are grateful to the Department of Transport for providing us with the storage, to house our fleet. We know locally owned Trishaws, stored in the community it provides for, enables us to deliver a practical and streamlined service.









Last week, we secured our largest grant yet. With Lotterywest giving us the nod to purchase two more Trishaws. Running at capacity, these Trishaws will allow us to provide for larger groups, within Sorrento Quay. We are now a fleet of five!





In conjunction with the Department of Communities we hosted a movie night at Event Cinemas, Whitford. In celebration of Thank a Volunteer Day, we gave thanks to our vollies and watched The Mole Agent, a beautiful Spanish movie, that very much resonates with our work.



Pictured with Motion by the Ocean Inc board, we celebrated our successes at our AGM on Wednesday; followed up with a garden party on the grounds of our Governor, Chris Dawson APM, yesterday.

On Australia Day this year, Motion by the Ocean Inc, was recognised as the Community Group of the Year at the City of Stirling, Australia Day/Auspire Awards. To be recognised for our work is humbling. Though to be recognised three years in a row, would suggest we are providing our services in a meaningful and sustainable way, with much trust and confidence within the community we provide for.







Partnering with North Shore Community Hub now means we cycle the entire City of Joondalup coastline, from Trigg to Ocean Reef. We are thankful to the council and Caitlin Collins MLA for the introduction, which means we can now permanently store a Trishaw on site at NSCH, allowing us to tap into the Mullaloo/Ocean Reef communities.

Of course free rides are not free to deliver. Here are some of the costs involved.

\$500

this equates to you supporting 10 rides; allowing 20 people to reconnect with the community in which they live

\$700

is the cost to service and maintain one of our Trishaws for a year

\$800

utility costs to store and charge our Trishaws a year

\$1,000

is the cost to replace a battery in one of our Trishaws

\$1,500

subscriptions and IT costs

\$7,500

this amount can be contributed towards our maintenance and operating costs for our Trishaw fleet and our MBTO van

\$10,000

is the cost to insurance our organisation for a year

\$18,500

is the value of a Trishaw, with accessories delivered to Perth

OUR IMPACT WITHIN THE COMMUNITY WE SERVE

We have three Trishaws, with two more due for delivery in April 2023.

As of January 2023 our passengers have clocked up a huge 40,100 passenger kms! That's from Perth to Sydney x 10!

We have provided for 4400+ Trishaw passengers, with 2023 on track to be our most impactful year yet.

60% of our Trishaw rides service aged care homes/disability services and private carers with their supported people. The existing passengers are those that live independently in their own homes, either locally or visiting from outer suburbs.

We provide meaningful rides, between 40 and 80 mins in duration. Free to the general public, we provide the most regular service of its kind in Australia.



39,000 meals from our Moving Food program have been collected and distributed to our supported people who need it most.
